

Romans 10:9-13

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

This simply means that in order to experience God's grace to save us from an eternal Hell and to have his power to help us repent of and forsake the sins that envelop our lives we must confess two things: First, we must confess what the Bible says about Jesus - That he is the sinless son of God, equal to God, died for and took on our sin, conquered death and rose again.

I Corinthians 15:3-4 KJV

For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

Second, we must confess what the Bible says about us - that we are sinners deserving eternal Hell. That even our righteousness or best works, in the sight of a Holy God, are like filthy rags.

Isaiah 64:6 KJV

But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

We cannot confess something that we do not believe to be true, otherwise we are lying. Your conscience should be telling you that the Bible is true when it says you are a sinner. There is, indeed, a God and he has preformed the miracle of giving us his very Word that he will judge us by.

Jesus claimed to be God and he proved it by raising from the dead. Many hundreds of eye witnesses saw him after he raised from the dead and spent their lives telling the world about what they saw. Many were even killed for their faith in Jesus but would not recant their testimonies. They had absolutely nothing to gain and everything to lose.

I beg you to consider the testimony of the Bible and "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling." Because one day "...every knee should bow... every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord..."

Acts 4:12

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

To recap:

1. God is an all seeing, all knowing, eternal being; this means he knows every time we have broken his just law.
2. God has one just punishment for all who have broken his law - Hell.
3. We have all broken God's law and therefore we all deserve to be cast into Hell.
4. God loves us and doesn't want us to spend an eternity in Hell.
5. God sent Jesus to die in our place and make us right with him if we only cry out in agreement with God.

Did you know that there is a government that can see everything you do?

A government that can see everything you do is a scary thought. You wouldn't be able to get away with anything. You could never break the speed limit without getting caught. We would all be getting tickets or going to jail, there would be no one unaffected by the all seeing government.

We are not talking about a conspiracy theory here. It's not the illuminati, or the Secret Society. We aren't even talking about the Alphabet company's/organizations like the FBI, CIA, NSA etc. It's much bigger than that.

Yes, there is a government that can see everything you do. It is God's government. The Bible states:

Proverbs 15:3 KJV

The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.

Because God is an omniscient [all knowing] being, He can see all that we do and even what we think.

He knows when we lie, and when we cheat; He knows when we commit fornication - that is having any physical relations outside of a biblical marriage covenant between one man and one woman.

He knows about our "drinking problem", or "smoking problem", or "cussing problem", or any other sin we call a "problem."

Instead of a speeding ticket, or some time in jail, God has one main judgment to pass down to all mankind: physical death, and spiritual torment in Hell. The Bible tells us:

Romans 6:23 KJV says:
"The wages of sin is death..."

Rev 21:8

But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

Yes, God sees everything and he won't let the "smallest" sin go by unpunished. Unfortunately, every single person on earth has broken God's law. We have all sinned and therefore we are all worthy of God's just punishment - Hell.

Romans 3:23 KJV

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

However God is not just some mean Oger that is in the sky to keep people from having a good time. It is exactly the opposite.

Do you think it would be a smart thing to run your car without oil? Or maybe drive on tires that have little to no air in them? Of course not, that will ruin the equipment. The designer of the car and tire give very specific guidelines on how to care for their product.

In a similar way God has given us guidelines on how to live. If we do not follow those guidelines we will not function as we should. God did not make us to be miserable, unhappy, lonely, depressed, stressed out, angry, sickly, broken people. All of those things come because of sin - either directly or indirectly. The Bible confesses that sin might be fun for a season, but when it is over it will bring destruction.

Because God made us, and knows what is best for us, he wants us to obey his rules, not because it helps him, but because it is what is best for us.

He wants our best because he loves us. The Bible tells us that God loved us so much that he came down and died on the cross for our sins.

John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

"Why does God love me?"

You might be asking yourself. The answer is easy. He loves us because he created us. For the same reason that a mother or father loves a child. The child is part of the parent. God loves us because he made us in his image.
see **Genesis 1:27 KJV**.

Also, God loves us because his nature is good.

1 John 4:8b,10-11 KJV

...for God is love...

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.

Just as God's nature is good, man's nature is fallen and sinful. Since the first man, Adam, disobeyed God, all of his children would be born with a fallen nature, needing God to intervene on our behalf and remove the curse of sin. It was always God's plan to redeem us (that is to buy us back) not with things that are temporal or corruptible, but with the most precious substance he could think of - the very life blood of his dear son.

1 Peter 1:18-20a KJV

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world...

God's love for you is so great that before he ever created you, he knew you would need to be purchased back by his own blood... and he chose you over all the suffering he knew that he would endure.

1 Peter 1:23-25 KJV

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

Jesus died, not only to save us from Hell, but to also give us a new nature. The Bible refers to this as being "born again."

How can we experience this salvation or new birth?
